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### **Airport to Issue Request for Proposal (RFP) for Industrial Land Development**

The Williams Gateway Airport Authority Board of Directors authorized staff on Monday to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for the development of approximately 400 acres of Airport owned land. The concept calls for master developers to submit a proposed site plan for all or part of the area and install all necessary infrastructure. In exchange, the Airport will provide development rights for a portion of the property benefited by the improvements. It is estimated that the entire area could accommodate over 3 million square feet of aviation and industrial facilities.

The RFP is expected to be issued at the end of this month with a pre-proposal conference planned for late June.

The Airport is owned and operated by the Williams Gateway Airport Authority that includes the Gila River Indian Community, Gilbert, Mesa and Queen Creek.
