Williams Gateway Airport Authority Elects New Chair

MESA, ARIZ. --- Mesa Mayor Keno Hawker was elected the Chairman of the Williams Gateway Airport Authority at the July 12 Board meeting.

Queen Creek Mayor Wendy Feldman-Kerr will serve as the Vice Chairman, Gila River Indian Community Gov. Richard Narcia will be the Treasurer and Gilbert Mayor Steve Berman will act as Secretary.

When Mayor Hawker was asked about his new position he said, "The relationship with the other Board members has been the most rewarding part. We understand this is to be a major economic center and knowing you have the same goal makes it easier and more rewarding."

The Airport Authority elects the Chair and other officers from the four Board members on an annual basis. The next Board meeting will be held at 9 a.m. on Monday, Sept. 20 at the Airport's Administration Building, 5835 S. Sossaman Road, Mesa, Ariz. The Board will also hold a Retreat on Sept. 10. Meetings are open to the public.
