MESA, ARIZ. --- Williams Gateway Airport will be hosting the T.W. Lewis *Talk, Walk, and Run* event Saturday, October 30 at 8:00 AM on the Airport runway.

WGAA will be closing its longest runway to accommodate the *Talk, Walk, and Run* event that includes an 8k competitive run, a 5k run/walk, and a 1-mile fun walk. T.W. Lewis is sponsoring the event with proceeds benefiting the Anasazi Foundation, the House of Refuge East and the Partnership for a Drug-Free America - Arizona Chapter. The course starts on the runway and takes participants through the Airport. Awards, prizes, and plane displays are just a few of the surprises that will be waiting for participants at the finish line.

Chandler-Gilbert Community College will participate in the event with their aviation program's aircraft on display. "It will be a fun event.
