Hurricane Relief Effort at Williams Gateway Airport

What: Ten general aviation aircraft will be loaded with medical supplies, diapers, and baby formula to be flown to Baton Rouge's Louisiana State University triage center in a relief mission for the thousands of displaced Southeast Louisiana residents.

When: Sunday, September 4, 2005
Aircraft loading is scheduled 8:00 am to 9:30 am
Aircraft are scheduled to depart by 10:00 am

Why: The American Red Cross has asked for additional medical supplies, diapers, and baby formula to assist their efforts in caring for residents displaced by Hurricane Katrina.

Who: The Arizona Pilots Association coordinated the operation. A total of ten privately owned single-engine and multi-engine aircraft will be loaded with supplies in a "Flight for Life" mission.
