



**Vision Airlines signs operating agreement for
passenger service from Williams Gateway Airport**

Flights to commence in first quarter of 2006

MESA, Ariz. (December 1, 2005) – The Williams Gateway Airport Authority today announced that Vision Airlines has signed an operating agreement to provide charter service from Williams Gateway Airport. The Las Vegas-based airline will commence service in the first quarter of 2006. The operating agreement does not stipulate schedules or frequency.

“We look forward to welcoming Vision Airlines to Williams Gateway Airport. Vision’s passenger services represent another important milestone as we continue to drive economic development in the East Valley and grow toward relieving Phoenix Sky Harbor International in years to come,” said Williams Gateway Airport Authority Chairwoman, Wendy Feldman-Kerr.

Williams Gateway Airport currently serves over 2,000 passengers annually on Allegiant Air charter flights to Reno and Laughlin. Other private charter flights from Williams Gateway Airport handle more than 25,000 passengers annually.
