



Williams Gateway Granted \$2.2 million to Improve Parking Facilities

MESA, Ariz. – April 24, 2005 – Williams Gateway Airport has received a federal grant to improve its parking facilities.

The U.S. Department of Transportation grant for \$2,276,417 will help to improve existing parking facilities at the airport along Sossaman Road. Specifically, the funds will help the airport pave dirt and gravel lots near its general aviation facility, administration building, and several hangar facilities.

“As Williams Gateway continues to grow in on-site jobs, general aviation traffic, and commercial passengers, parking becomes a critical issue. We’re pleased to receive this grant to ensure we are safely accommodating visitor parking needs,” said Lynn Kusy, Williams Gateway Airport Authority Executive Director.
